Graduates enrolled in the current Registered Nurse Graduate Program undertake 6 months of training at both Barwon Health and the GORH (Lorne Community Hospital) over a 12 month period. While in Lorne, we aim to develop our graduate to work effectively in each of these departments by offering experience, mentoring and guidance. Our clinical team have regular in house education sessions as well as access to shared education with Colac Area Health, Hesse Rural Health and Otway Health and sessions run by the EMET team at University Hospital. Great Ocean Road Health also has an extensive array of online learning opportunities including the Rural Urgent Care Nursing Program offered through Alfred Health.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications for 2021 graduate programs open on Monday 13 July and close on Wednesday, 5 August 2020. It is important to remember that late applications will not be accepted.
