

Palliative care encompasses the physical, emotional, social and spiritual well-being of the person. Care and support can be delivered in many ways, with options of in their home or in a clinical setting. A connection to palliative care within our community will provide nurturing for the person and their families as they transition towards end-of-life and support during the bereavement process.

Many patients and families are now requesting to receive palliative care in their own home and familiar environment. This fundraising appeal aims to deliver further staff training so that we can support the person with regular visits and specialist equipment such as infusion pumps for symptom management, portable hoists and helping with communication with medical teams via telehealth.

Lorne campus has a wonderful palliative care space within the hospital which can be accessed for end-of-life care or short stays for carer respite or symptom management to ensure all involved in the dying process are valued and nurtured.
